

Peer Perspectives.... The Fairway Snake®

Tom Leahy, CGCS has been the Head Golf Course Superintendent at Sleepy Hollow Country Club in Scarborough, New York for more than 20 years.

Tom has been using the Fairway Snake for the past few years.

"I have two 150 foot Snakes, one for each side of the course. Each snake gets used every other day during the course of the season."

Tom knows the Fairway Snake is used by many superintendents to remove dew- getting golfers on the course earlier and also reducing disease potential. Others use it for removal of earthworm castings. Tom's primary reason for using it is to disperse grass clippings after they mow. "It helps clean things up on the fairways. If you drag in the opposite direction of the mowers you can stand the grass back up and create a nice clear surface for the golfers."
